

BYLAW NO. 07-05

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LANDIS TO LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION AND EXTINGUISHING SERVICE DIRECTLY ON PERSONS WHO RECEIVE THE SERVICE.

Pursuant to subsection 8(1)(b)(i) and Subsection 42(2), and Section 369 of *The Municipal Act* The Village of Landis in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That the cost of fire prevention and extinguishing services be billed directly to the person or persons who receive the service.
2. That the cost of outside fighting prevention or extinguishing services regardless if the members of the volunteer firefighters or 911 requests the help will be billed directly to the person or persons who receive the service.
3. That the cost of false alarms of fire prevention and extinguishing services be billed directly to the person or persons who request the service.
4. That the “person who receives the service” be defined as the registered owner or the person whom is paying rent to the registered owner of the property or land, building, vehicle, or other materials residing on the property.
5. That the rates for the above mentioned services be set by bylaw of council and these rates will be as follows:
 - a. False Alarms: \$100.00
 - b. Grass or leaves out of control: \$500.00
 - c. Out buildings, vehicles, or other material located on property: \$1000.00
 - d. House or place of business: \$1000.00
